

## Music & Dance of Kedewatan At Puri Bayu

The village of Kedewatan has a very fine Gamelan Orchestra and Dance Troupe that regularly performs at the Temples and at the resorts of Amandari, Four Seasons and Kupu-Kupu Barong. We have organized performances here at the house (Puri Bayu) many times over the years for ourselves, guests and for the villagers.

The Kedewatan Dance Troupe performs the Legong Dance and the Frog Dance accompanied by the entire Gamelan Orchestra...in the living room!

The current price per 2 hr. dance direct to the Banjar is Rp.1,500.000.

They also perform the Kacak Dance with about 70 men plus dancers.

The current price for the 2 hr. Kacak direct to the Banjar is Rp.1,500.000

Tingklik players are also available (2 Bamboo Gamelan players and a person on bamboo flute). They usually position themselves on the pool deck and provide a lovely, quiet accompaniment to lunch or dinner.

The current price direct to the performers is Rp.300.000/2 hrs.

Djoged Bungbung Dance is also available and usually performed up at the Badminton court. This is a Tingklik (Bamboo) Orchestra of 10 or more players who accompany 4-5 female dancers who with a touch of their scarfs, invite the spectators to join them in the circle for a dance and **no** whimping out!

The current price to performers is Rp.1,500.000/2 hrs. plus.

The staff of Puri Bayu can organize this for you and they are usually available unless previously committed for a particular date.

The price is paid directly to the performers or via the staff. Prices are subject to change so please ask the staff to check when you reserve. It is customary to provide drinks (ie. coffee or soft drinks) for the performers and perhaps Rokoks (Balinese kretek cigarettes). If you are a small group and it is not intrusive, it is very welcome to invite the neighbouring Balinese (all of whom helped build Puri Bayu) to watch the performance.
